This 1940 Chevrolet Pickup was among the first modern pickups produced by Chevy beginning in 1937, ushering in a more modern, streamlined design.

It features a "Stovebolt Six" 216 cubic inch inline 6-cylinder, 85 horsepower engine. 3-speed manual transmission. 113-inch wheelbase with overall length of 192 inches.

It has been immaculately restored and runs great! The donors, the McAsseys of Newfane, drove it up to Vermont when they purchased the truck in Rhode Island 13 years ago – the engine has 5,000 miles on it.
